Welcome to the July fact sheet for EAAP 2016 in Belfast

Arriving in Belfast

Visit Belfast will have a help desk in reception and at the two Belfast airports.

Most hotels and the conference venue are in Belfast city centre which is a short taxi ride from Belfast City airport or slightly longer bus journey (45 mins) from Belfast International airport.

Belfast is a compact city and most hotels are within walking distance of the main bus and train station. Google maps will help you find your way to your hotel and the conference centre .

Waterfront venue

On the banks of the River Lagan the brand new conference venue is easy to get to.

USEFUL TIPS EAAP 2016

What to wear

The Belfast WEATHER is always mixed and exciting so be prepared. Bring a range of clothes including a waterproof jacket, hat and umbrella. If you are going on any of the tours please bring outdoor shoes. The temperature during the day will be around 15C with nights a little cooler. Our City Reception and Titanic experience dress code is smart casual not formal. Social events like St Georges Market, Prof in the Pub or Pub Quiz are all casual.

Electric

Bring adaptors for your devices and computers as the electricity points are 240v 50Hz. Outlet is a 3-pin type. We will have USB charging points for phones.

Money

N Ireland has its own sterling currency (£) but Scottish and English pounds are all accepted. When you go home try to use your NI currency in Belfast as some places outside NI are not keen to accept it! There are lots of ATM bank machines in.

Emergency Numbers

Telephone 999 or 112 for fire, police and ambulance. Telephone 101 for non- emergency medical matters. The EU medical card is valid in UK. If you are feeling unwell ask at your hotel or the Waterfront reception.
